

Brother Mike Dudley, a LMI Senior Consultant, currently serves as Team Lead and Senior Acquisition Subject Matter Expert (SME) for the U.S. Border Patrol Counter-Unmanned Aircraft System (C-UAS) program. Provides SME advice to government customer personnel, and ensures the program stays on track (performance, schedule, and cost) to meet customer and stakeholder expectations. Provides leadership and mentoring to over 12 LMI and other support contractors assigned to C-UAS. Prior to his current C-UAS assignment, performed similar duties as Team Lead for the Mobile Video Surveillance System program and as Senior Acquisition Specialist for Tactical Aerostat System program.

Mike, a retired career Department of Defense civilian, came to LMI from Defense Contract Management Agency (DCMA) Stockton. There he served as civilian director of a DCMA contract management office supervising over 270 civilian and military personnel and responsible for managing 10,300 contracts valued at \$23 billion. DCMA Stockton provided oversight over 900 large and small contractors producing or sustaining national defense/space products such as aircraft, ship and satellite components, launch and combat vehicles, electronics, and spare parts. DCMA Stockton provided oversight over contractors located in Alaska, Washington, Oregon, Idaho, California, and Nevada.

Prior to DCMA Stockton, Mike was deployed to Camp As Sayliyah, Qatar to the U.S. Central Command (CENTCOM) Joint Theater Support Contracting Command as Deputy Director, Contract Support, Plans, and Operations providing theater contracting support to U.S Forces Afghanistan. Previously, he served in the Office of the Deputy Assistant Secretary of the Army (Procurement) as Workforce Development Director working to reshape U.S. Army headquarters contracting staff and U.S. Army worldwide military and civilian contracting workforce.

Mike has a bachelor's degree from the University of Virginia (UVA) and a master's degree in National Security and Strategic Studies from U.S. Naval War College and is a Graduate of Federal Executive Institute. He is a certified Project Management Professional (PMP) and is certified Production, Quality, & Manufacturing Level III, Program Management Level III, and Contracting Level II, from Defense Acquisition University.

Mike is a 1979 Initiate of the University of Virginia Chapter, the Eta Sigma of Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity, Inc. He has served as Keeper of Exchequer for the Berkeley (CA) Alumni Chapter and immediate past Keeper of Exchequer of the College Park/Sandy Spring Alumni Chapter. 
