




College Park Sandy Spring Chapter Brother Spotlight

I was born and raised in Durham, North Carolina, November 1954, to Rev. Clifton and Ida Mae Bullock. (Yes, I am a "PK" – Preacher's Kid). My father is my one hero in my life. A Southern Missionary Baptist Minister, who was blind since the age of 22 due to glaucoma. He (and my mother) worked very hard to provide a loving home and provided us with all we needed and most of what we wanted. I do have one sibling, Clementine Clark, Retired Air Force, Nurse and a proud graduate of Duke University.

Graduated top ten of my graduating class from Southern Durham High School and earned a fouryear football scholarship to East Carolina University (ECU), Greenville NC. I pledged Kappa Alpha Psi, during my sophomore year, (Spring 1975). Very proud to be on the first line (after Chapter Chartering) and the first athlete at ECU to pledge Kappa. After graduation with a BS degree in Industrial Technology, I worked for Union Carbide Inc, in Greenville and later moved to Maryland.

It was at ECU that I met my spouse, Cheryl (a beautiful member of Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority Inc.) to whom I have been married thirty-nine years this December. We have been blessed to have two children, Nicole and Benjamin.

An avid bicyclist, to which I have participated in many century rides (100 miles). I am also an active member of the Exceptional Persons Ministry – a ministry to serve persons who are differently-abled (special needs) and their families. This ministry is special to my heart as my daughter is differently-abled. In addition, I have been the Head Coach for Special Olympic Basketball for young Adults in PG County for 25 years.

I love to spend time with my family, road cycling, my fraternity brothers and my church family. I am a pretty laid-back kind of guy and very easy going.

Gerald "G-Money" Holland

After graduating from Flint Northern H.S. in 1981, Gerald joined the U.S. Navy. After bootcamp and aviation maintenance training, his 1st duty assignment was Naval Air Station, Corpus Christi, TX, on the flight line launching, recovering and inspecting T-28 Bombers. After two years, Gerald changed jobs to become a payroll clerk beginning a new career in financial management. After attending school in Meridian, MS, Gerald was stationed at Recruit Training Command, in Orlando, FL for ten months managing pay accounts for new recruits. His 3rd duty station was on-board USS Yellowstone, where he managed more than 300 pay accounts. During deployments, Gerald visited over twenty countries including Naples, Rome and Gaeta, Italy; Toulon, Nice and Monte Carlo, France; Haifa and Tel Aviv, Israel; Rota, Spain; Greece, Croatia, Dubai, Bahrain and Turkey. In 1999, Gerald was selected to lead the travel support department in Naples, IT during the Kosovo crisis. Gerald was awarded the Navy and Marine Corps Commendation Medal which was the highest honor for that mission.

In 1995, Gerald received an A.A. from Berkley Community College, Oakland, CA and a B.A. in Management from St. Mary's Business School in 2004. While in Oakland, Gerald supported the Court Appointed Special Representative Program where he mentored youth in the judicial system and spoke on their behalf during court hearings.



Gerald's final deployment was in October 2000, and he retired from the U.S. Navy in 2001, after serving 20 years. His last assignment was as Deputy Disbursing Officer managing day-to-day financial operations. After retiring from the military, Gerald worked at American Express, DHS, and currently, DoS as a Senior Budget Analyst, managing eleven programs totaling \$360 million dollars in government spending.

Gerald comes from a family of five boys and one girl. He attended Quinn Chapel A.M.E. Church, the oldest Black church in Flint, MI. His mother and father have passed on, but not before laying a foundation of God, independence and self-determination. Gerald has been married to LaVerne (Delta) for 20 years and has two children, Kendi and Kadin. His daughter is a sophomore at Morgan St. and son is an 11th grader at Wise H.S.

Becoming a brother in Kappa Alpha Psi has been about continuous growth and development as well as meeting other aspiring men, sharing like interest. It's good to be a Kappa Man!
